As announced last fall, Development and Peace — Caritas Canada is beginning a new campaign cycle this year. Encouraged by our Orientation Assembly in June 2022 and inspired by the October 2021 address of Pope Francis to the World Meeting of Popular Movements, we have chosen the theme *Create Hope* to guide our actions over the next five years. At the Orientation Assembly, our keynote speaker and guest of honour, Cardinal Michael Czerny, spoke along the same lines.



"[...] today it seems there's a real scarcity of hope. So there's need for artistry, poetry, creativity. And that isn't just idle words or pretty words. That means changing the basic things that are leading to our hopelessness, and those are the selfishness and the self-centeredness that are built into our economic, social and political systems."

How can we create hope? By taking action! Because the best antidote to despair is action. We hope to mobilize our membership in creative ways to bring about the change we want to see, and with it, the hope of a better and more just world.

Under the broad theme *Create Hope*, you are being invited this year to *Stand for the Land*, in solidarity with our sisters and brothers in the Global South who are defending their homelands by protecting their land and water, the environment and human life. Through the pages of the Minimagazine, you will be transported to Colombia and Honduras. In March, you will also have a chance to meet solidarity visitors from those two countries, as well as from Cambodia.

It is with great joy that we invite you to join the Share Lent campaign that Development and Peace has been organizing for over 55 years. This time of preparation for Easter is a time of fasting, prayer and almsgiving. Every year, Development and Peace invites Canadian Catholics to donate to the **Solidarity Sunday collection** (**March 26**, this year). Your donations support projects that transform lives and communities!
