In the face of this, you might ask: what can we do? Well, at Development and Peace we choose to support grassroots organizations that defend the dignity and the rights of the poor. These are our partners. Every day, thousands of faithful women and men heed the cry of the earth and the cry of the poor, as Pope Francis exhorts us to do. Every day, they mobilize to speak out against injustices inflicted upon the poorest of the poor. Every day, they call on us for support, for solidarity and for commitment. They **Stand for the Land**, and we must stand with them.
