We look forward to introducing you to the new theme of the *Create Hope* campaign for 2024, which is *Reaping our rights*.

Together, we will be mobilizing in solidarity with peasant farmers around the world, who face many challenges when all they want is to live in dignity. We will be meeting partners and communities from Bolivia, Indonesia, Tunisia and Nigeria who are joining forces to ensure that their rights to land, seeds, biodiversity, water, justice, food, food sovereignty, a healthy and safe environment, health, education and equal opportunities for women are respected.

Perhaps you think we are getting a bit ahead of ourselves this year? Well, that is because we want to take on a new challenge: **printing the** <u>exact quantity</u> of material ordered, to avoid shortages, surpluses or delays.
