FOOD AND NUTRITIONAL SECURITY AND CLIMATE CHANGE IN THE SAHEL (SANC2S)



CONTEXT

The Food and nutritional security and climate change in the Sahel project (designated by the French acronym SANC2S) addresses the issue of food insecurity, which is being exacerbate across the central Sahel by political instability, armed conflict, climate change and inflation.

In Burkina Faso, Mali and Niger, millions are affected by a worrying decline in food security.

- Improve the sustainable management of natural resources in communities affected by climate change.
- Increase the profitability of economic activities carried out by agricultural producers.
- Promote inclusive governance by ensuring that gender equality and the interests of vulnerable groups are considered in the formulation of food security policy.
